Vintage Notes

With abundant early season rain followed by excellent spring and summer weather, the beginning of the 2022 growing season in Sonoma was near ideal. An intense heat wave followed by cool rains in September quickened the pace of ripening but allowed the fruit to reach its fullest potential before being carefully pulled off the vine. This cooler vintage produced grapes with complex, fruit-forward flavors and balanced acidity.

Food Pairings

Enjoy these balanced flavors with asiago cheese, wild mushroom and leek crostini, caramelized onion risotto, grilled lamb chops with fresh rosemary, or grilled tri-tip with roasted red peppers.
