Tasting Notes

A beautiful and delicate pale straw hue lends itself to this bright Sauvignon Blanc. Aromas are captivating with ripe melon, lime oil, guava, green apple, and subtle notes of fresh cut grass. Crisp on the entry, the palate is framed by mouthwatering acidity and notes of citrus, white peach and under ripe apple. The clean finish is fruit-forward and lasting.

Vintage Notes

With an overall cool growing season that started in the spring and lasted into fall, the 2023 harvest was about two to three weeks later than previous years. Although the grapes were picked later than usual, the flavor development arrived before sugar development resulting in wines full of depth and complexity. As grape quality was high across Sonoma County, 2023 has so far proved to be an exceptional vintage.

Food Pairings

Pair this food friendly white wine with a fresh platter of tropical fruits, burrata, pasta primavera, or spicy chicken enchiladas.

Growing up in Sonoma, we spent a lot of time exploring the local countryside: finding our way through neighboring vineyards owned by old friends and family. I remember the excitement of discovery and freedom while thoroughly studying our small town and its outskirts. I remember old dusty roads that led to forgotten vineyards and properties...
