**Vintage Notes**

With an overall cool growing season that started in the spring and lasted into fall, the 2023 harvest was about two to three weeks later than previous years. Although the grapes were picked later than usual, the flavor development arrived before sugar development resulting in wines full of depth and complexity. As grape quality was high across Sonoma County, 2023 has so far proved to be an exceptional vintage.

**Food Pairings**

This Petite Sirah pairs perfectly with a salame and charcuterie board, and Moroccan-style grilled meats seasoned with turmeric and paprika. It also complements anything roasted or charred.
