The 2024 vintage in Sonoma Valley delivered exceptional quality, thanks to a balanced growing season marked by a cool, wet winter and a mild, extended summer. Consistent temperatures allowed for slow, even ripening, preserving natural acidity while enhancing flavor concentration. White wines like Sauvignon Blanc show crisp energy, expressive tropical profiles, and striking minerality.
